- Equities: Stay overweight in infrastructure, defence, digital-tech; hedge tariff-sensitive cyclicals.
- Fixed Income: Build around 3–5-year AAA corporate bonds amid steady RBI stance.
- Commodities: Silver & copper remain strong; crude expected to hover at \$68–70/bbl.
- Forex: INR projected in 82.8–83.5 range; monitor US tariff shifts and rate dynamics closely.
