Global Macro & Geopolitics

1. **US-China Trade Tensions:** US Supreme Court expresses skepticism on existing tariffs, signaling potential legal battles ahead, even as the Trump administration continues to revoke non-immigrant visas.

- 3. **Telecom Stake Sale:** Singtel's Pastel is set to lower its **Bharti Airtel holding** with a significant block sale of ₹10,300 crore. Stocks to Watch.

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- 4. **Promoter Action:** From Tata Motors to Raymond, a growing trend of **top Indian firms taking the demerger route** is noted to unlock shareholder value and achieve operational focus.
- 5. **Banking Sector Structure:** Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman reiterates that India needs a lot of **big, world-class banks**, with talks ongoing with the RBI and lenders.

- 10. **Corporate Legal Action:** The Enforcement Directorate (ED) summons Reliance Group chairman **Anil Ambani** again in a money laundering case.

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- 2. **AI Stock Correction:** Wall Street's major indices, especially **Nasdaq**, settled in the red overnight due to persistent concerns over high valuations in the Artificial Intelligence (AI) sector.
- 3. **Commodity View: Gold prices** surge to record highs amid global risk aversion, while oil prices remain mixed.
- 4. **FPI/DII Activity:** Domestic flows continue to stabilize markets, nearing parity with Foreign Portfolio Investors (FIIs) in terms of ownership gap.
